The following statement appears when these sites are accessed and a accept button must be selected before access is granted:

"The website you are attempting to visit is a social networking environment. Army Regulation 530-1, Operations Security (OPSEC), prohibits disclosure of critical and sensitive information in any public domain to include but not limited to the World Wide Web, open source publications and the media. Do not publicly disseminate or publish photographs displaying critical or sensitive information. Do not publicly reference, disseminate, or publish critical or sensitive information that has already been compromised.
